Steps to AVID Membership

- Step 1 The district identifies an AVID District Director and commits the DD to AVID District Leadership (ADL) training over a two- year period.
- Step 2 The district will receive an email from AVID Center prompting the district to complete the "Contract and Quote Request" online.
- Step 3 The district completes the "Contract and Quote Request" online and submits to AVID.
- Step 4 The district begins the pre-planning process and commits to sending a minimum of eight members to an AVID Summer Institute (includes an administrator, counselor, lead teacher, and subject area teachers).
- Step 5 AVID Center emails the AVID Implementation Agreement to the district Contract Contact.
- Step 6 The district submits a signed AVID Implementation Agreement to AVID no later than June 30, 2015.

District Value Packages

AVID District Leadership (ADL) Training (Only required for NEW AVID districts)—ADL training is a two-year, intensive cycle of trainings providing the AVID District Director (DD) with the tools and skills needed to leverage the AVID system in the district.

Additional Leaders ADL Training (Optional)—After the first District Director is trained, any additional participants in ADL training will receive the "All Additional District Leaders" rate for as long as the district stays in the AVID System.

2015 AVID Summer Institute—Summer Institute registration for the District Director (DD) attending the DD Strand and assisting with their district's site teams is complimentary. The district superintendent may also attend Summer Institute free of charge. (Associated travel expenses are the responsibility of the district.)

School Value Packages

Annual AVID Membership—Annual membership entitles the school to a wide selection of workshops (face-to-face and online) on topics related to AVID implementation, ongoing consultation with AVID staff, curriculum resources and training, professional development, site certification, comparative data collection, access to members only website, AVID newsletters and other publications, licensing for reproduction of student materials, and limited use of AVID logo and intellectual property. Please see the Sliding Scale offered for districts implementing AVID in 10 or more schools.

2015 AVID Summer Institute—Summer Institute is high-quality professional learning conducted for content and AVID Elective teachers as well as administrators over a three-day period. First-year implementation requires an AVID site team of eight (8) that includes an administrator, counselor, lead teacher, and subject area teachers. *Attendance at Summer Institute is recommended for continued program quality but is *not required* after the first year as part of the Agreement, so it is not included in the total cost below. Fee shown is for early-bird pricing. (Associated travel expenses are the responsibility of the school.)

AVID Libraries Package—Libraries include all curriculum, resources, and materials needed to implement AVID with fidelity across your campus. A one-year subscription to AVID's online critical reading resource, "AVID Weekly," is included for up to 20 educators at the school. All updates to implementation curriculum are available at no cost through MyAVID, as well as access to additional electronic curriculum and lesson planning resources. (Price includes shipping and handling.)

AVID Tutors—For the AVID Elective class to be implemented with fidelity, tutors are key components. The cost of tutors may vary depending on the number of AVID Elective classes and hourly compensation paid to the tutors. A school district/school should estimate the number of tutors needed and budget accordingly. AVID does not provide these services and these costs are not collected by AVID.

AVID District Director (DD)

AVID Program Managers will provide guidance, support, and training to the DD and schools throughout the year. Careful consideration should be taken when selecting a DD. The ideal District Director candidate is a district-level person who has worked as a coordinator or director of one or more educational programs, as an assistant superintendent, or has recently had the role as the district's AVID liaison, and who will be able to stay in the DD role for several years.

The time commitment for the DD will vary based on the number of AVID schools, school locations, and the depth and breadth of the

implementations of AVID in your district. AVID Center can provide guidance if you have questions regarding selecting the right person with the appropriate skill set as an AVID District Director.
