SUBJECT:

Request for Approval to use FY2014 General Fund for Capital Expenditures

State Board of Education approval is being requested for the following school districts to use fifty thousand (\$50,000) and/or five percent (5%) of the district's FY2014 General Fund for Capital Expenditures pursuant to 70 O.S. 70 § 1-117 and OAC 210:25-5-4.

All of the below districts have voted in excess of eighty-five (85%) bonded indebtedness within the preceding three (3) school years and the maximum five (5) building fund mills required to seek the State Board of Education's approval for fifty thousand (\$50,000) of FY2014 General Fund to be used for Capital Expenditures.


