The Oklahoma State Department of Education has analyzed the results of the 2021-2022 vision screening, in response to state law [70 O.S. § 1210.284](#), detailing the number of Kindergarten, first grade, and third grade students who received vision screening, who failed the vision screening (received school referrals), and who received comprehensive eye exams from eye care professionals based on the school referrals.
