

## **District Adoption Timeline**<sup>1</sup>

Semester	Phase	Action	Checklist
Fall	Preparation	Establish the Process	<ul> <li>Define the <b>parameters</b> of adoption (e.g. budget, decision-making process, technology needs).</li> <li>Create a <b>timeline</b> and milestones from adoption to launch.</li> <li>Assemble the <b>district adoption committee</b>. It should include 3-9 members including a local community stakeholder, a chairperson who is a principal or curriculum specialist, and teachers of the subject currently considered for adoption.</li> </ul>
		Develop the Lens	<ul> <li>Establish an instructional vision for the content area that explains what teaching and learning for the subject area should look like.</li> <li>Collect and analyze district data (e.g. student achievement, classroom observation, teacher experience).</li> </ul>
Spring	Investigation	Know the Choices	<ul> <li>Identify available programs for the grade(s) and content area(s).</li> <li>Research existing evaluation(s) of programs to learn about alignment and other features of quality.</li> <li>Gather anecdotal information about programs from other districts and/or subject-matter experts.</li> <li>Narrow the selection to 2-4 material sets.</li> </ul>
		Explore the Materials	<ul> <li>Review the completed rubrics for each state-approved program to determine how each address identified district priorities.</li> <li>Contact publishers and request samples and presentations.</li> <li>Determine professional learning needed for the implementation of each program.</li> </ul>
	Adoption	Make a Decision	<ul> <li>Compare the strengths and gaps for each program.</li> <li>Analyze stakeholder feedback.</li> <li>Assess the implementation support needs for each program.</li> <li>Use the local committee process to make a final selection.</li> <li>Communicate decisions and next steps (e.g. ordering, distribution).</li> </ul>
		Implement	<ul> <li>Create a learning plan that progresses from "getting to know" the materials to use them to teach.</li> <li>Establish a feedback system for responsive professional learning.</li> <li>Ensure time and site support for teachers using the adopted materials.</li> </ul>
