1.	District has articulated purpose(s) of Early Childhood Outcomes (ECOs).					
2.	Administrator explains the articulated purpose(s) of its ECO measurement process.					
3.	District has a written statement to share that addresses why data are being collected and how data will be used. Statement specifies who will use the data and for what purposes.					
4.	District staff fully understand why ECO data are collected and how they are being used for program improvement.					
5.	Families receiving services are fully informed about the purpose of collecting data on ECOs.					
6.	Administrator goes beyond saying that ECO data is used for program improvement to give examples and explain how it is used.					
7.	Written statement about the purpose of ECO data collection is easily accessible to the administrator, staff, and the general public.
