Darci Forrester opened a discussion centered around two questions related to technology in the learning environment. Panel members provided their input, with answers varying for each question. The answers to the questions are summarized below:

• "How can we use technology to help educators?"

- Provide training focused on helping teachers and administrators utilize the technology they already have (ex: Canvas, Google Classroom, etc.)

 - Parents need a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) sheet or similar resource when an issue occurs with their child's online learning platforms.
 - Parents are not trained on technology and neither are the students. Both cannot teach each other how to use it without knowing how first.
 - Administrators need to provide assistance and opportunities for parents and students alike to learn how to best utilize the online learning platforms.
