PREVENTION POINTER:

BEING TRAUMA-INFORMED MEANS SHIFTING YOUR LENS FROM ASKING:



Chances are that the "bad" behavior you are seeing is a survival mechanism that has been triggered by something even the child is not aware of – such as a smell, sound, tone of voice/volume, word, or facial expression. You cannot be "perfect" in your expressions and interactions – but you can be informed in your responses. If your radar is going off, because the child is acting out, then chances are that this is the moment you shift your lens, and find out what happened. Making simple statements such as "I see you are upset" can open the door to communication. Then, we can find out what triggered the behavior, and see if we can help the student learn a new way of responding to the engrained trauma pattern.

Availability of drugs at school ^{21,23} ⊗ ... School anti-drug policies ¹⁷


