One-Day Child Count 12-1-2022

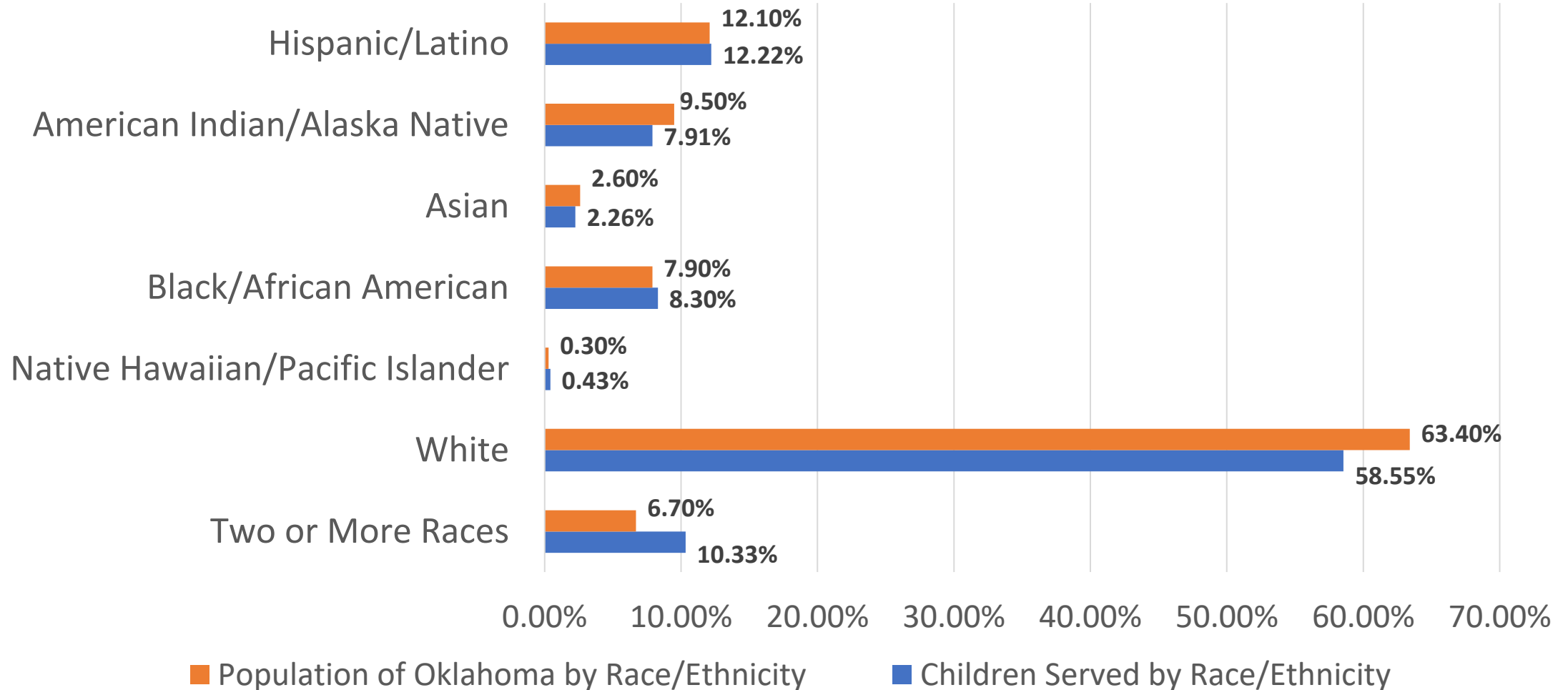
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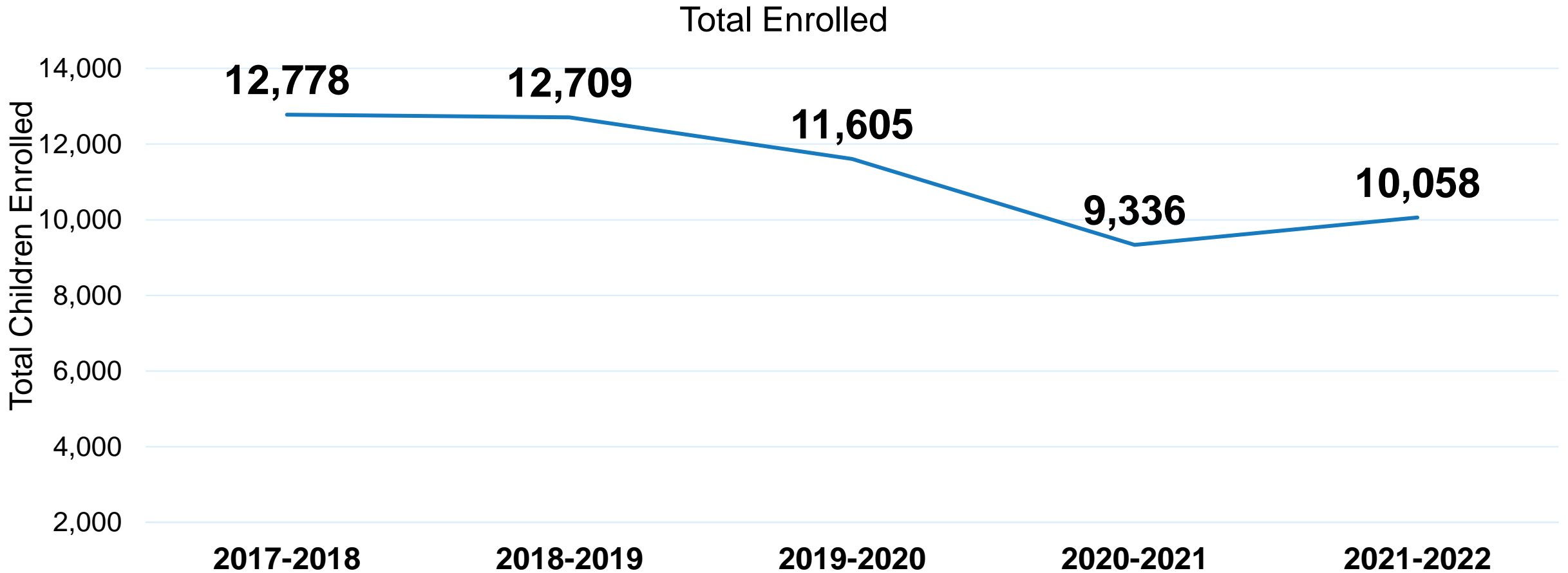
Cumulative Child Count 7-1-2021 to 6-30-2022

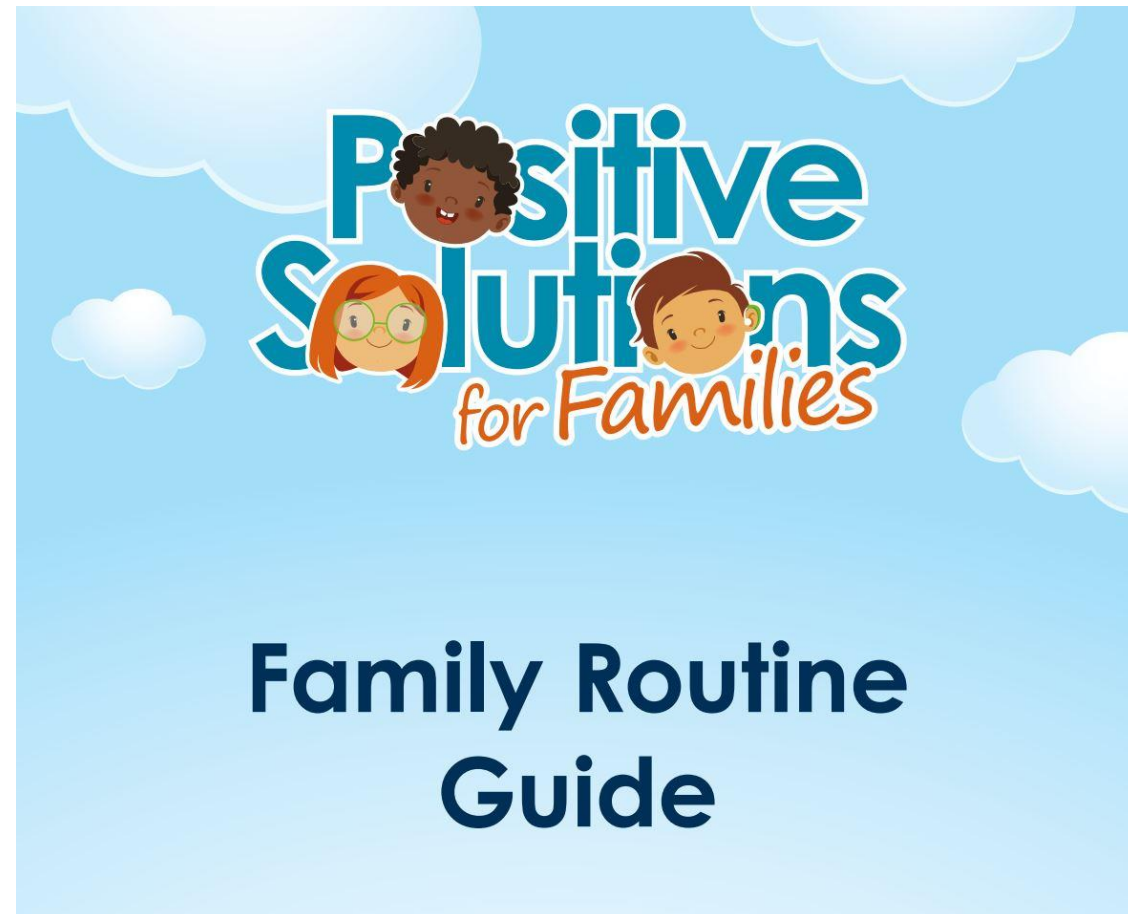

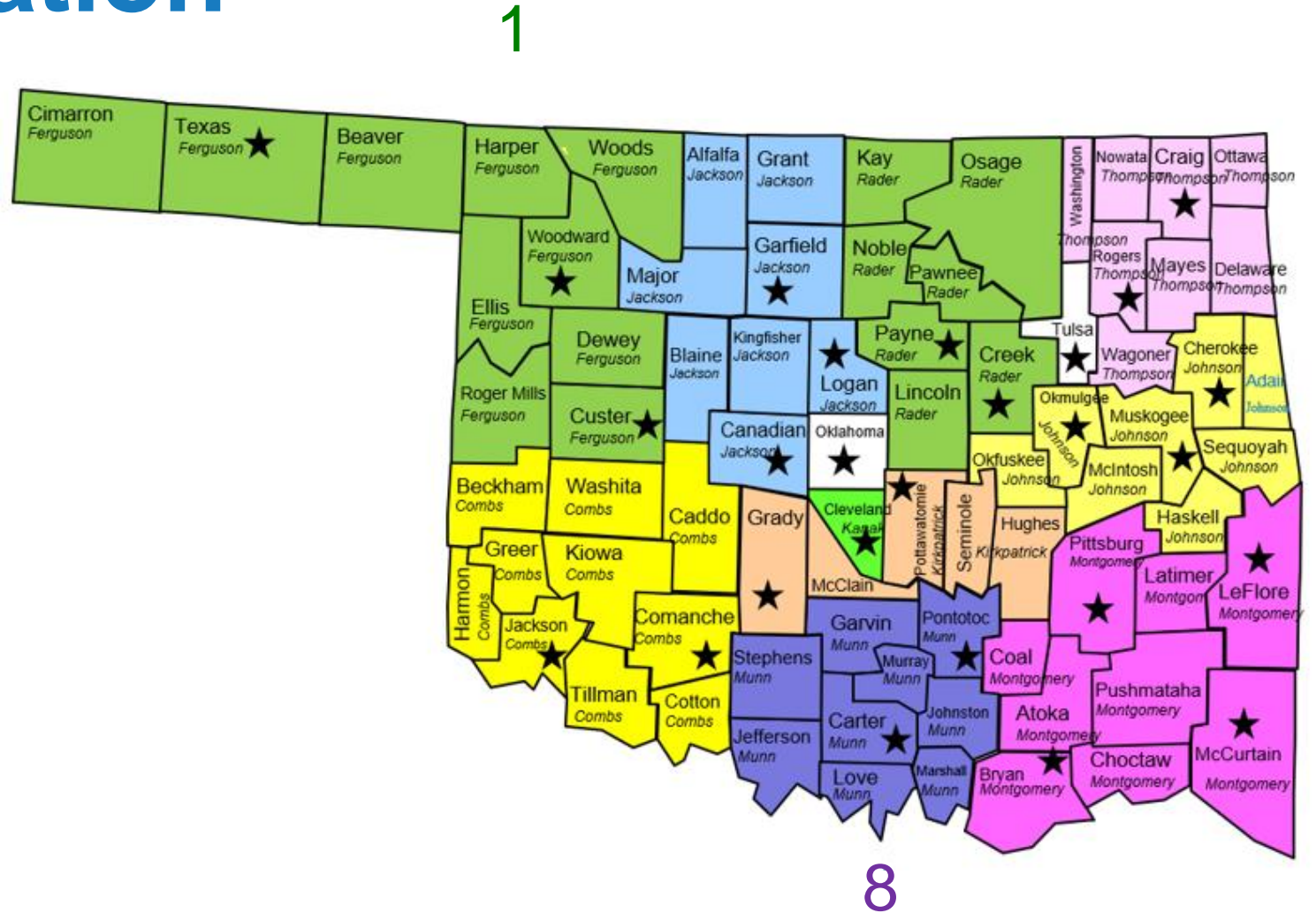
