SUBJECT: Statutory Waiver Concerning Substitute Teachers

The following schools are requesting a statutory waiver of 70 O.S. § 6-105, which requires a school district to request a waiver of the restrictions on total time a substitute teacher may be employed from the State Board of Education for a substitute teacher who does not hold a valid certificate. To receive this waiver, the school district must submit information about the availability of certified substitutes and also about the qualifications of the substitute teacher. Approval is recommended.
